Route	Activities
Day 1 Arrive at Managua International Airport	Participants arrive at Managua Int, Airport. Orientation to health and safety guidelines, schedule review and introductions. Orientation on current events in Nicaragua
Day 2 Granada and Masaya	Visit to the volcano and to the crafts market of Masaya. Artisans in "San Juan de Oriente", members of the "El Gueguense" cooperative. Visit to the colonial city of Granada. Free time to explore and enjoy the city.
Day 3 Managua: history and development projects towards women	History of the organizational struggle of women. Financial corporation for small businesses: Credit programs for women. Organization of human rights: Women's rights in assembly plants. Central American women's fund. Women's cooperative: New life assembly plant.
Day 4 Sexual diversity: Rights and Society	Encounter with the Nicaraguan Lesbian Group: Sappho and Gay Group for Sexual Diversity: Legal situation of homosexuals, government support, struggling situation and opportunities. Visit to the "Xochiquetzal" Center: Foundation for a prejudice free society.
Day 5 Matagalpa: history, reproductive sexual health, Struggle for women's rights	Sandinista Worker Association: Struggle for domestic working women's labor rights. Women's collective of Matagalpa: Encounter with members from different areas and developed projects. Women's, Children's and Adolescent Police department. "Venancia" Group: Educational group and feminist popular communication. Catholic members for the right to decide: They protest against the repeal of therapeutic abortion
Day 6 Rural communities and women in cooperatives	Indigenous community "El Chile": Weaving group "Telares Nicaragua" and to the "Grupo La Malinche". Rural community "La Pita": Cooperative women producers of recycled paper, producing women, members of the cooperative union of fair trade.
Day 7 Women in the revolution	History of the war, Social repercussions, politicals and economic for the population, conversation with former warriors of the popular Sandinista Revolution and with surviving women from the war of the 1980's. Workshop of black ceramic. Maternal House: Shelter home for pregnant women coming from rural zones, where parental care and after birth care is given to them. Visit to the María Cavallieri: weaving women's group Between Strings.
Day 8 Estelí: Support network for women that live in domestic violence	Sun Crafts and Art. Foundation Between Women Visit. Assistive Investigative Center of Women: Shelter home for victims of intra family and sexual violence. "Xilonem" Women's association.
Day 9 Condega: Crafts and Environment	Environmentalists Women's Cooperative "OLOCIKA" (La Tunoza - Estelí). Recycled paper artisan producers based on natural wastes. Visit to the association: Constructing Women in Condega. Workshop of Women's empowerment through the teachings of a non traditional technical job like carpentry, welding and electricity. Visit to the Artisan Women's Cooperative of "Ducuale Grande".
